Welcome	Dr Ariaraj welcomed everyone to the meeting, and explained the role of the guest speaker.	
A2H	Maggie Johnson introduced herself to the group. She is a Nurse Clinician commissioned by the Commissioning Consortium until 31/3/14. A2H is Alternative 2 Hospital, and consists of 3 nurses, 2 admin staff and 1 Health Care Assistant. The service enables patients to stay in their own homes where possible, or short term Care Home stays, arranging care packages to suit the patient and accessing essential equipment or services. Initially assistance is for 2 weeks, but can go on longer. Maggie explained that it is difficult to access Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy, and that the service has funding to be able to facilitate this. It was decided that a person-friendly leaflet would be beneficial explaining to patients what A2H is, and Maggie kindly said she will get a draft copy of this to Sally to distribute to members of the PPG. Doctor/Staff Changes	Dr Ariaraj explained the roles of the current GPs Dr Taylor is Senior Partner. He specialises in Cardiology Dr Arthur's specialities are Orthopaedics, muscular problems and Homeopathy Dr Cullumbine specialises in Gynaecology and contraceptive advice. Dr Ariaraj's specialities are Endoscopy, Child Health, Lead Minor Surgery and is a GP trainer. Also there is Dr Edwards, speciality Kidneys, Dr Williams speciality osteoporosis, and Dr Cox, Dr Fraser and Dr Douglass. There are 4 new registrars joining the practice by the end of the week.
